E-WASTE RECYCLING IN PENANG, MALAYSIA - 2005

Penang's Recycling Programme – 2001-2005

The Penang State Government started its recycling programme in Hillside, Tanjong Bungah, in 1993, following the Federal Government's first recycling programme, launched earlier in the same year. This kerb-side programme was limited by collection problems.

In November 2000, the Federal Ministry of Housing and Local Government relaunched its recycling programme with a 3-bin system, followed by a collection centre programme in December 2002. The Penang State Government re-launched its recycling programme with the same 3-bin system on 10th March 2001.

On 12th October 2002, the Right Honourable Dr. Koh Tsu Koon, Chief Minister of Penang, launched Penang's Community Recycling Programme. This programme mobilises community organisations to carry out recycling activities.

The Honourable Dr. Teng Hock Nan, State Exco Member for Local Government, Traffic Management and Environment, then launched Penang's Hazardous Waste Collection Programme (7 June 2003), Computer Recycling Programme (24 February 2004), Household Composting Programme (8 July 2004) and E-Waste Recycling Programme (7 January 2005). On 30th December 2003, the Honourable Dr.Teng Hock Nan launched Penang's Community Recycling Taskforce, an umbrella organisation for recycling communities in Penang.

E-Waste (Electronic and Electrical Waste) Recycling in Penang

This recycling programme aims to reduce the pollution of Penang's environment by hazardous and toxic substances in E-waste, particularly heavy metals and halogens.

Study on the Recycling and Safe Disposal of E-Waste – 2003 / 2004

In 2003, the Chief Minister of Penang commissioned the above study in the K-ICT Council of Penang. In 2004, the Municipal Council of Penang Island (MPPP) approved funds for the study and the study was completed in November 2004.

Computer Recycling Programme – 2004

On 24th February 2004, The Honourable Dr. Teng Hock Nan launched Penang's Computer Recycling Programme to recycle used computers and computer parts. This programme was organised by Dell Asia Pacific Sdn., HMR Resources (Malaysia) Sdn. Bhd., the Municipal Council of Penang Island and the Municipal Council of Seberang Perai.

E-Waste Recycling Programme – 2005

On 7th January 2005, The Honourable Dr. Teng Hock Nan, State Exco Member, launched the Penang State Government's E-Waste Recycling Programme. This programme was carried out by PEWOG (the Penang Environment Working Group) with the assistance of NKH E-Waste Trading and Suiwah Corporation and its Sunshine Supermarket chain.

The Role of the People

We are all waste generators and amongst the waste we generate are E-waste, that is electronic and electrical waste (listed below). Keep the E-waste in your house until you send and/or sell the E-waste to the community recycling teams on their recycling days.

The Role of Community Recycling Teams

Community Recycling Teams are urged to collect and/or buy E-waste from the residents and to pass or sell them to the recycling agents for recycling and safe disposal.

The Role of Recycling Agents

All the recycling agents in the State should collect and/or buy E-waste from the recycling communities in the State for recycling and safe disposal. All e-waste can be taken up by Agents and sent to Buyers who will pay them for the E-waste. These Buyers are listed in the recycling directory published by PEWOG, the Penang Environment Working Group, "The Recycling Wheel of Penang".

The Role of Buyers, Processors and Convertors

Buyers will buy E-waste from recycling agents, sort them and send them to the Processors for dismantling, crushing, shredding and baling. The Processors will then send the material to the Convertors who will turn them into useful materials and products.

Residue from the processing and conversion is then sent to the <u>secure landfill</u> in Bukit Nenas, Negri Sembilan, or to Safe Processors (overseas companies).

The Role of the Government

The State Government of Penang, through PEWOG (Penang Environment Working Group, a tripartite body of community, private sector and government organisations), plans, initiates, coordinates and monitors the E-Waste Recycling Programme.

List of E-Waste (Electronic and Electrical Waste)

- a. Items paid for:
- 1. Computers Computer CPU and Computer monitor.

b. Items collected free-of-charge at the community recycling centres:

Big floor & wall-based items: Refrigerator, washing machine, airconditioner, etc.
Small table-top household items: Fan, stove, grinder, etc,
Entertainment items: Radios, CD and DVD players, Television set, etc.
Office items: Telephone, fax machine, computer parts, printer, etc.

Static Collection Centres for used computers and computer parts:

a. Penang Island: Dell (Phase 4, Bayan Lepas) and MPPP Store in Kampong Jawa Lamab. Seberang Perai: Dell (Bukit Tengah) and MPSP Stores in Jawi and Mak Mandin.
